Requirements for participation

The prerequisite for participation in the DFG individual grant writing workshop is a concrete project idea outlined on one page. This first step - namely formulating a concrete project idea - is often time-consuming and should therefore be completed before the application workshop begins.

The decisive factor for participation is not the quality of the project outline, but only the fact that you already have a concrete project idea that you can work with during the event. Participation in the application workshop is not possible without an existing abstract.

The concept of your own project idea must be sent as a PDF document by e-mail to antragswerkstatt@tu-dortmund.de by **April 21, 2025** at the latest.

Formalities

The following formal requirements must be observed when preparing the concept:

- The length of the concept as the basis for a subsequent funding application must not exceed one page (Arial 11, 1.15 line spacing).

- Please name your file according to the following pattern: Abstract_surname_firstname

Requirements of the concept (approx. 1 page)

- Length: approx. one page.

- Include brief information on your academic background and the status of your DFG proposal.

The concept should be divided into the following sections. These are suggestions and ideas that we consider to be an important basis for a project proposal from a research funding perspective. These guidelines are not mandatory, but can be understood as suggestions as to how you can structure this concept.

1. Working title/draft/idea

2. Initial situation (state of the art) -> What open research question(s) do you see in relation to your planned project?

3. Objectives and research question (1/2 page) ->What are the goals of the project?

Formulate 2-3 concrete goals

4. Work program (1/4 page) Give a rough outline of the project approach. Which methods will you use? What steps and sub-areas are you planning as part of the project?
